Stroll through the quiet streets of **Almedinilla**, where whitewashed houses blend into the very rock of the hills.

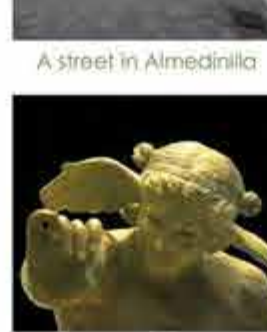

The exceptional sculpture of the Greek god **Hypnos-or Somnus** as he was known by the Romans - must be seen, along with the mysterious figure of an ancient **Hermaphrodite** deity, and a collection of **Iberian pottery**, all in a countryside setting of incomparable beauty.

You can enjoy an unforgettable day, when we invite you to a **journey back to Roman times**: after visiting the archaeological sites, you take your place as a guest at a Roman feast, participating in all its ceremonies and traditions, and savouring the tastes of history. An authentic banquet is recreated for you.

The overwhelming impression of **Carcabuey** is the mediaeval castle which dominates the town-the focal point for the many cultures which have thrived here, and left a rich legacy which permeates the town's streets and squares. Inside the castle's walls is settled the shrine of "**El Castillo**", which offers a delightful contrast between its whitewashed Andalusian walls and the imposing masonry of the castle.

A wander through one of the many attractive neighbourhoods will take us to the parish **church of La Asunción**, in which we can see great examples of sculpture by the renowned Granadan school of craftsmen, such as the Christ of All Souls, by Alonso de Mena.

We can also get into the charming little **church of San Marcos**, or the shrine of **Santa Ana**.

But above all, Carcabuey excels in its numerous viewpoints offering a magnificent panorama of the **Sierras Subbéticas national park**-here, we are at the very heart of nature.

The streets of **Castil de Campos** offer all the charm of a country way of life, meticulously maintained by carefully-guarded tradition. The town is divided into two neighbourhoods-the **Barrio de los Chirimeros**, and the **Barrio del Otro Ejido**-which are huddled around the fountains of the same names. One is characterised by its steep paved streets laid out in terraces, and the other is noted for its attractive fountain and its historic communal laundries.

The town centre is the main square, with the beautiful and much-loved **church of Our Lady of the Rosary**. Castil de Campos is particularly impressive for the number of **vantage points** from which to admire the wide-open spaces of the Andalusian countryside, especially from the **shrine of the Corazón de Jesús, the Sacred Heart**.

Then there are the ancient **caves** dotted throughout the hills, where shepherds used to take shelter from stormy weather. And in the **Folk Museum**, the visitor can contemplate the rural life that our ancestors used to lead, recreated in every detail.

At first under the Iberians, and later under the Romans, **Fuente Tójar** was at the centre of social, political, and economic life in the sweep of land between Priego and Alcaudete, as we have learned from the priceless archaeological evidence unearthed in the hills of **El Cerro de las Cabezas**.

This eloquent testimony to a fascinating past can be admired in the town's local **history museum**, where impressive remains from both cultures are on display.

Traditional architecture abounds in the streets and squares; of particular interest are the parish **church of Our Lady of the Rosary** and the **shrine of Calvary** in the highest part of town, or the unusual **municipal market**, which was built in 1929.

From the heights of **La Canteruela** there is a splendid view over the town amid its wealth of olive groves.

Fuente Tójar is a community which has carefully maintained its dearest traditions, such as its **Danzantes**-its festival dancers -keeping alive a custom which otherwise could become lost for ever.

When we speak about **Priego de Córdoba**, we are talking about the monumental beauty of its grand buildings, which stand out everywhere we turn.

The beautiful **Old Quarter**, with its Moorish origins, is a labyrinth of narrow winding streets laden with flowers, which envelop the visitor in a gentle atmosphere of days gone by. The bewildering network of streets unravels onto the stately serenity of the **Balcón del Adarve**, with its astonishing vista over the rolling Andalusian countryside. The mediaeval **castle**, the ancient **slaughterhouse**, the majestic fountains of the **Fuente del Rey** and the **Fuente de la Salud** are just some of the monuments for which Priego is justly celebrated. There are also **museums**, all of them in great houses with a history of their own.

The town's numerous churches offer a vivid illustration of the Andalusian baroque style which reached a breathtaking climax in the eighteenth century. The magnificent sacristy in the parish **church of La Asunción** is nothing short of overwhelming; equally impressive are the **churches of La Aurora, del Carmen, San Francisco, Las Mercedes, San Juan de Dios, Las Angustias, and San Pedro**.

Customs and Celebrations

• **ALMEDINILLA'S** rich cultural heritage brings with it not only its well-known Roman banquets, but also the season of celebration known as **Festum**. The town bursts into colourful life with Roman feasts, funeral banquets, a Roman market, and any number of attractions taking the town's Iberian and Roman past as its theme. During the night of the festivity of San Juan (24th June), there is a performance of the legend of **La Encantá** – the bewitched maiden – with a colourful procession headed by the mythical masked figures of **Los Dócalos**.

• **CARCABUEY** is a town which preserves and strengthens its traditions, with numerous festivals throughout the year. Of particular interest is the **Pascua de los Moros**, a carnival recognised nationally as of tourist interest, which is celebrated on the Resurrection Sunday; the festival of **Corpus Christi**, with its procession through town streets carpeted with brightly-coloured sawdust; and there is the bull-running festival known as **El Toro de Cuerda**.

• **CASTIL DE CAMPOS** maintains ancient traditions such as the musical festivals known as **Los Villancicos la Chancharilla**, and **Los Coros de las Candelas**.

Another very important festivity is San Anton's day, with its procession of the piglet, sausage auction, and blessing of animals—all customs whose origins have been lost in the mists of time.

• **FUENTE TÓJAR** is best known for an unusual festival which is featured by eight male dancers in brightly-coloured dresses who perform traditional steps to the same music as their forefathers. They are called "Danzantes" who wind their way to the shrine of San Isidro every May 15th.

• **PRIEGO DE CÓRDOBA** has a packed festival calendar, which lends the town its particular charm.

Carnival is an explosion of joy, colour, and fantasy; it takes place before the solemn contemplation of Easter.

Holy Week is marked by spectacular processions of the town's most emblematic religious icons, which are carried through the streets with a touching and heartfelt ceremony. Each of the sacred figures is displayed in an impressively elaborate setting during the festivals of the **Sundays of May**, which are recognised nationally as of tourist importance. There are well-attended charity auctions and processions on every Sunday of the month.

Corpus Christi is celebrated with a particularly beautiful procession through the Old Quarter of Priego, specially decorated with flowers and its walls freshly painted for the occasion.

The pilgrimage of **Our Lady of La Cabeza** takes place in June, when the image of Our Lady is borne by ox-cart to the picturesque shrine near the village of La Concepción, high in the Sierra de los Judíos.

Among the many traditions still maintained locally is a special affection for **flamenco** singing, which can be enjoyed at many festivals, and in performances within the various flamenco societies.

A related and equally ancient art is that of the **Troveros** – modern-day troubadours who craft spontaneous and improvised verses, often with biting wit. One of the best-loved traditions, which goes back to the sixteenth century, is kept alive by the **Brotherhood of La Aurora**, who roam the streets of Priego de Córdoba every Saturday night, singing well-known songs handed down by our forefathers.

Nature



Priego de Córdoba's region is located deep in the heart of the **Subbética National Park**, which is recognised as a **Geopark** by UNESCO.

The most striking natural feature is its stunning Karstic rock formations: it is a land of gorges, caves, and narrow valleys, a home to a fascinating array of flora and fauna in an ever-changing landscape.

The **Sierra de Horconera** mountain range presents a daunting wall of solid limestone, with the peaks of **Bermejo** – 1476 metres high – and **La Tiñosa**, the highest mountain in the province at 1570 metres.

Mediterranean woodland predominates throughout the whole park; particularly interesting are the holm oaks – some of them are centuries old – and quejigos, a bushy variety of oak, dotted among the many native plants that line the river banks.

The particular climate of these mountains encourages a rich variety of plant species, some from the Subbética region, others from much further afield, such as lilies, narcissi, or peonies, as well as any number of attractive alpine plants.

The beautiful **Sierra de Albayate** towers over the fringes of the national park: it is classified as a mountain range of special environmental interest, and home of the greatest concentration of holm oaks in the south of Córdoba province.

The mountains are particularly worth visiting for the sheer quantity and variety of mushrooms, truffles and other fungi, which has led to the establishing of a **Mycology Garden**, a special attraction for all lovers of the natural world.

There are many ways to enjoy this countryside to the full: walking, bicycling, or horse riding – these are just some of the possibilities from which the visitor can choose.

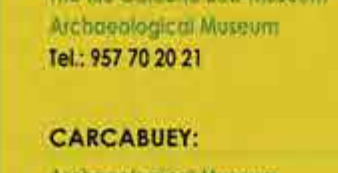

La comarca de Priego de Córdoba está inmersa en pleno **PARQUE NATURAL DE LAS SIERRAS SUBBÉTICAS**, declarado Geoparque por la UNESCO.

Lo más destacado de este entorno natural es el bello modelado kárstico de su roca. Tierras de simas, cuevas y estrechos valles, sorprende la variedad de parajes que nos vamos a encontrar, con un excepcional interés paisajístico y ecológico.

En la **Sierra de Horconera**, sobresale el pico **Bermejo** (1.476 m.) y la cima más elevada de la provincia de Córdoba, **La Tiñosa** (1.570 m.) formando un impresionante macizo calizo.

El bosque mediterráneo está presente en todo el parque, sobresaliendo las encinas (algunas de ellas milenarios) y quejigos, así como la vegetación propia de las riberas.

Las peculiares características de estas sierras, la hacen rica en numerosas especies endémicas béticas, ibéricas, norteafricanas y locales, como los lirios, narcisos o peonías, junto a una serie de arbustos de gran belleza.

Fuera de los límites del Parque Natural, se levanta la bella **Sierra de Albayale**, tipificada como Complejo Serrano de Interés Ambiental, que conserva las mayores concentraciones de encinas del sur de Córdoba.

Otro atractivo de estas sierras es la abundancia y variedad de setas, trufas y hongos, que ha dado lugar a la construcción del **Jardín Micológico**, marcando un destino turístico de naturaleza rural y de gran calidad.

Estos parajes se disfrutan con intensidad, ofreciendo al viajero la posibilidad de practicar numerosas actividades como senderismo, rutas en bicicleta, rutas a caballo, etc.,
