This small and simple church was probably built towards the end of the 16th century and in its interior a beautiful image of Alonso de Mena, the Christ of San Marcos, is preserved.

Church of Santa Ana

Pilar Fountain



Formerly called Fuente de Los Caños, it was built in the 18th century to give the town aspect of a relevant city.

Our Natural Environment



Carcabuey occupies a privileged place within the Natural Park of the Sierras Subbéticas, being the municipality with the highest proportion of protected land its municipal area is located in the geographical center of the Park.

Geology is one of the most outstanding aspects of the

Gorges and escarpments of calcareous rock stand out among high reliefs of clay-like nature.

Human influence is very present in these mountains White hamlets and the green of the olive groves are integrated into the rocky landscape in a balance of unique beauty.

There are several places located in the municipality of Carcabuey but among the most significant we can mention: the Sierra de los Pollos or Jaula with average altitudes of more than 1,000 m it is perhaps the most characteristic mountain range of the Park due to its stepped alignment. majestically on the limestone rock. And of course, La

The water occupies a characteristic place within the municipality of Carcabuey outcropping in natural springs such as Fuente Catalina, El Navazuelo, Fuente Dura, Las Palomas. The Masegal,..., offering places where it overflows like the Hoyones and Los Pozuelos.

There is also throughout the Carcabuey town the presence of gall oaks with centennial specimens, maples, hackberries, carob trees, junipers and junipers that along with floral botanical species such as lilies, daffodils, or peonies give the landscape a rich variety. In terms of fauna, we can mention large mammals such as wild boar, wild cat, badger, genet, beech marten, marten, weasel, polecat or

For those who practice hiking, the region contemplates various marked routes (on foot, by bike or motor vehicle) that run through the most picturesque places from which you can see the most beautiful landscapes.

Town of Algar



Algar is a village of Carcabuey located about 8km in the South West direction. The Name of Algar comes from the Arabic Al-Gar and means Cave. There is the gloomy cave next to a farmhouse. As for the history of this small town, it is closely linked to that of the municipality of Carcabuey. Algar must have been one of the towns donated by Fernando III to the Order of Calatrava on the border lelimited by the Bishopric of Jaen.

Nowadays the population of Algar is decreasing. A few hundred inhabitants populate the village dedicating themselves mainly to agriculture, harvesting olives. It crosses the Arroyo de las Tijeras.

The village of Algar has La Venta Bar-Restaurant, multiple use buildings, park, church, etc., very quiet and beautiful place where to enjoy nature, hiking, breathing fresh air.

Castle of Algar



The Castle of Algar is located on the top of a hill today as ruins or archaeological remains, perhaps of Roman origin at first, as in its surroundings are ceramic remains of both the Bronze Age and Roman period.

The current castle can be dated back to Nasrid period, although it was rebuilt several times by Christians. It had a certain defensive importance according to the materials used, with large stone blocks joined by mortar, capable of resisting enemy attacks.

Of this primitive construction, only the ruined abortion of two-story tower remains, and a wall that joined with another tower and that kept an interior fountain that supplied the fortress.

Traditions and **Festivities**



The Pascua de los Moraos (Easter of the Moraos) is about all a representation of the local culture. To come to see it is to wish to feel it again, and to be a spectator of it implies participating in successive years. For all these peculiarities and for being unique "Carnival", together with that of Cádiz and Las Palmas de Gran Canaria, which survived the dictatorship, in 2006 it was declared a Festival of Tourist Interest of Andalusia.

The Easter of the Moraos serves to break with the everyday life of Carcabuey: children who disguise themselves as old, old people who disguise themselves as women, women who disguise as monsters ..., everything has a place in this strange carnival and everything is lived in the street where the festival reaches its peak, the participants are the inhabitants themselves who transform and live in an intense way those moments.

Easter Sunday in Carcabuey is a meeting point for many inhabitants not only of the Subbetic area, but of many other peoples, who come to live this festival on a Sunday that breaks with what is the traditional commemoration of Easter Sunday

Rope Bull



The Rope Bull is a bullfighting celebration held in Carcabuey since time immemorial in which the boys run through the streets in front of the bull that marches to their free will and only when there is danger of catching, they pull the rope that leads subject to antlers.

Currently with two releases, one in honour of the Virgin of La Aurora and another to the Virgin of El Castillo, correspond with the celebrations that we celebrate in honour of both virgins.

This festival attracts thousands of people from all over the region including from other provinces and communities.

Corpus Christi



The Corpus Christi is the faithful reflection of the religiosity of a people and one of the most excellent aesthetic manifestations of the Carcabuey calendar.

Thanks to the good work of several local artists, three magnificent carpets enhance the route of the procession in Virgen Street, Las Angustias and Pletil.

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Castle Festivals



At the beginning of September the Festivities arrive in Honour to Mary Most Holy of el Castillo, Patron Saint of Carcabuey. They are a few days marked in the town, which coincide with September 8 for being the Patron's Day.

Within the program of cults and parties sports activities are developed, highlighting the Night Trail of the Castle of Carcabuey organized by Umax Mountain Series.

Musical festivals, bars drinks, popular lunches and activities for all audiences are happening during these days thanks to the Brotherhood of the Castle.

The second release of the traditional Rope Bull organized by the Toro de Cuerda de Carcabuey Association is also celebrated. An appointment marked in the Carcabuey calendar by the number of visitors that attracts this activity and that fill the streets of the route marked with security fences for runners and spectators.

The festivities begin on Thursday with the act of Coronation of the Queen of the Festivities and her court of honour, elected by popular vote during the month of August, and which highlights the proclamation of the festivities that starts the programming of activities that will develop in the following days.

Within the program of cults and festivals sports activities are developed, such as the Nightly Popular Race 'Virgen de la Aurora', musical festivals, bars drinks, popular lunches and activities for all audiences are happening during these days thanks to the Brotherhood of la Aurora.

At night the booths offer performances of musical groups and commercial music into the early hours.
